- More than 900 museums
  - Mostly from Germany and Hungary
  - Publish their collections together
  - Many use museum-digital for collection management







IIIF relies on server-side image manipulation

To offer a IIIF API, one needs to host the media files







#### **Security considerations**

- Content security policies (CSPs) allow restricting access to external resources
- IIIF viewers require "connect-src" access to external resources for comparing images from different sources
- IIIF viewers ideally should be hosted on an independent subdomain if comparing images is allowed
- museum-digital's Mirador has comparisons disabled

#### **Lessons learned**

Let people know about your implementation!

Don't use imagemagick!

Accept incompleteness (external images, CSPs)

Regardless, the IIIF ecosystem is full of good tools. Everybody is very happy about the implementation (museum workers, researchers, funding bodies).
